Minutes for March 4, 2014 Akron Alanon Intergroup Meeting

Call to order: 7:30pm by Roberta T. The Serenity Prayer was recited and the Traditions were read. Members introduced themselves by first name, group affiliation and position.

Secretary (Gloriann H) Report:

There were 2 corrections to the minutes of 2/7/14. One, Kathy H (Paradise AFG, Wednesday and Stow New Hope, Monday) was added to the attendance list. Two, the entry under "New Business" stating that Phil B's group uses a portable doorbell was not related to meeting issues due to weather. Some churches lock the doors when the meeting begins and Phil B stated that they use a portable doorbell to alert the group that a member who arrived late is outside the locked door.

Jeff B made a motion to accept the corrected minutes and waive the reading of the minutes. The motion was seconded by Irena H and unanimously passed.

Co-chair (Jeff B) Report:

1. 33 newsletters were mailed, 24 newsletters were emailed. Jeff B noted that the mailings are likely to drop by 50% because several subscribers have not renewed their subscriptions. Jeff B has notified those subscribers. Irena H suggested that newsletters still be mailed to non-paying subscribers but the group disagreed.
2. Phil B also stated that the newsletter is available online for free

Treasurer (Monica C) Report:

1. Financial statement was reviewed. Monica C noted that a check in the amount of \$280.77 was given to Shelly D for an Alateen mailing; Alateen also purchased pens in the amount of \$110.
2. Irena H made a motion to accept the Treasurer's Report. The motion was seconded by Jeff B and unanimously passed

3. Laurie K (Treasurer Co-chair) presented the proposed budget for 2014. She noted the following: Rent will remain the same, the newsletter amount will drop from the 2013 amount because of fewer subscriptions, the PIC and MOW line item amount will be significantly less than 2013. Given the actual amount spent in these 2 categories in 2013 Phil B suggested that the 2014 amount is more accurate. He also suggested that if PIC and MOW need additional monies they can make a request to Intergroup.
4. Irena H suggested that "Archives" should be a line item on the 2014 budget. Laurie K stated that Archive expenses have previously been noted under "Misc" The group agreed that "Archives" will now be a line item. Phil B suggested that Laurie K ask Leah E (Archivist) for an appropriate amount.
5. Janet S motioned to accept the Proposed Budget. Irena H seconded the motion and it was unanimously passed.

Literature (Janet S) Report:

1. Janet S stated that there is still a 3 week delay in Literature deliveries.
2. Janet S ordered 20 of the newest "Alanon and Alateen Groups at Work" but last years edition was delivered. They do not need to be returned so Janet S offered them along with an instruction sheet entitled "The Forum Writing Guidelines" to the group for their Alanon Groups.
3. New service manuals are on order.
4. Janet S also said that she orders literature by the case to save costs.

PIC Report:

1. Roberta T said that ADM Crisis Center in Akron is putting together an information packet and requested Alanon Literature be included. The group suggested that the pamphlets entitled "Detachment" and "Are You Troubled By Someone's Drinking" be sent to ADM. Irena H suggested that Intergroup absorb the annual cost of approximately \$73 for the pamphlets; the group agreed. Phil B suggested that the PIC Chair (Jerry M) coordinate the plan with the ADM personnel

MOW Report:

1. Jeff B said that Brandon (MOW Chair) has a schedule change for 2014. Brandon will contact Richie (Webmaster) to advertise the necessary change.
2. Roberta T will be giving Brandon old Forums for use at MOW.

Alateen Report:

1. Linda K (Alateen Chair) was not able to attend the sponsor meeting but she will be attending the Assembly.
2. Roberta T will be talking to Linda K re the Founders Day Skit. Linda K is coordinating the skit but she is unable to attend Founders Day. Also, Mickey will be handling the Alateen section on Founders Day.
3. Falls PM still needs an Alateen sponsor. Roberta T will talk to Linda K and Rex M also offered to research the problem since that is his home group. Kathy H suggested that the Alateen designation be taken off the meeting schedule until the matter is settled.
4. There are 2 active Alateen Meetings: Tuesday Triangle and Brunswick, which is declining. Kathy H suggested that we do a mass mailing like the one that was presented to us last month by Shelly D. of Brunswick.

Office Coordinator (Roberta T):

1. 27 calls in, 20 calls out, 20 voicemails, 22 literature orders, 3 meeting schedules mailed and 2 professional calls
2. The office was covered for 18 out of 20 possible days.

No reports for OAA Liason, Districts, Archives, Gratitude Night

Webmaster Report:

1. Jeff B asked if the website is currently monitored. Roberta T said she will call Richie and ask him to update the site.

Steering Committee:

1. Jeff B and Phil B proposed 2 items for Founders Day; book bags and bookmarks. The group chose a bright green nylon bag printed with "Founders Day, Akron, Ohio." There was a suggestion that the Alanon logo also be printed. Our cost would be about \$2.65 each for 100. The bags would sell for \$4.00. Phil B and Jeff B found the laminated bookmarks to be too expensive. Irena H will research other bookmark options and report her finding at next month's meeting.
2. Roberta T suggested that we get a new stamp for Founders Day. Janet S will look for a stamp that is not self inking and has a changeable date.

Founders Day:

1. Olin Hall at Akron U will be the Alanon site on Founders Day. Olin Hall is only a short distance from the Student Union but there will be golf carts available for those unable to walk.
2. AA asked us to let them know when the speakers are arriving so they can make hotel arrangements.
3. Cheryl from Akron U will post Alanon signs. Phil B suggested that a map be made showing the route to Olin Hall from other parts of the campus and it should include restroom designations. The maps should also be in the Literature Room. Irena H suggested that a poster size map on easels throughout the venues would be helpful.
4. The 5th Year AA coordinators are compiling a History of Founders Day. Jeff B gathered historical information and emailed it to the coordinators
5. Judy M will be making wall hangings for the Fri night speakers. Mugs were suggested for the other speakers. Jeff B asked the group to approve \$200 for gift expenditures. Irena H motioned for approval, seconded by Kathy H and unanimously passed.
6. Jeff B stated that Founders Day registration began March 1; 360 people have registered in the amount of \$32,000

2. The theme is 8th & 9th Step
3. We are still looking for one speaker

Old Business:

1. The audit is ongoing as per Phil B

New Business:

1. Roberta T asked Lisa T to formulate a new petty cash procedure. Irena H suggested that we print a form and Phil B stated that receipts should be included when money is taken. It was also noted that there be a specific procedure for donations to the petty cash. Until a system is in place Monica C and Laurie K asked that a note be left in the petty cash box.

The meeting adjourned at 8:55pm and The Lord's Prayer was recited

INTERGROUP / NEWSLETTER NOTES

Founders' Day

1. Olin Hall is the site for the Al-Anon Panel meetings, Skit and Workshop.
2. Google Maps suggests getting to Olin Hall from all directions by using the Carroll St. / Buchtel St. exit off of Route 8.
3. There are three or more parking lots close to Olin Hall.

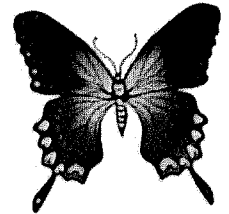
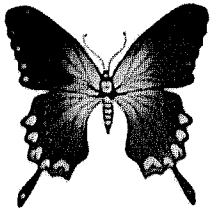

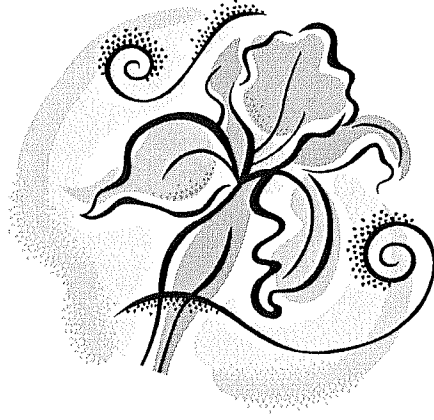
Local to Akron? Here are directions from the Akron Area Intergroup Office to Lion's Park Lodge

Take Manchester Rod to I-277E/US-224E. Take for 2.5 miles. Merge onto I-77N via Exit 4B toward Akron. Take for 2.7 miles. Keep left to take OH-8N via Exit 125A toward Cuyahoga Falls. Go 6.2 miles. Take OH-59 /Front St Exit, Exit 6, toward Stow. Go 0.2 miles. Turn slight right onto Front St/OH-59E. Go 0.1 miles. Turn left onto Bailey (if you reach Edison St, you've gone too far). Turn left onto Jennings Avenue. Go 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Oakwood Dr. Go 0.02 miles. Take the 1st left onto Silver Lake Avenue. Address is 641 Silver Lake Avenue. **(14.70 miles - about 21 minutes)**

From Downtown Canton, Take I-77 N toward Akron, then take Exit 125A toward Cuyahoga Falls, OH-8N for 6.2 miles. Take the OH-59 E/Front St exit, Exit 6, toward Stow for 0.2 miles. Turn slight right onto Front St/OH-59 E for 0.1 miles. Turn left onto Bailey Rd (if you reach Edison St you've gone too far) take for 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Jennings Ave and take for 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Oakwood Dr. Go 0.02 miles and then take the 1st left onto Silver Lake Avenue. Address is 641 Silver Lake Avenue. **(28.41 miles - about 36 minutes)**

From Downtown Cleveland, Take I-77 S toward Akron, then take Exit 156 onto I-480 toward Youngstown for 12.1 miles. Take I-271S toward Akron/Columbus for 3.4 miles, Merge onto OH-8, via Exit 18A on the left toward Boston Hts/Akron go 10.5 miles, Take Graham Exit (Exit 7) toward Silver Lake/Stow and go 0.2 miles. Turn right onto Graham Rd. Go One mile and then make a slight left onto 8th Street. Turn slight left onto 8th Street (if you reach Prior Dr you've gone 0.2 miles too far). Turn left onto Silver Lake Avenue. Address is 641 Silver Lake Avenue. **(35.15 miles - about 45 minutes)**

From Downtown Youngstown, Take I-76W toward Akron, take for 36.3 miles, then merge onto OH-8N via Exit 23B toward Cuyahoga Falls and go 6.1 miles, Take the OH-59 E/Front St Exit 6 toward Stow and go 0.2 miles. Turn slight right onto Front St/OH-59 E and go 0.1 miles. Turn left onto Bailey Rd (if you reach Edison you've gone too far) go for 0.6 miles. Turn left onto Jennings Avenue. Go 0.4 miles. Turn right onto Oakwood Dr. Go 0.02 miles and then take the 1st left onto Silver Lake Avenue Address is 641 Silver Lake Avenue. **(54.75 miles - about 1 hour)**

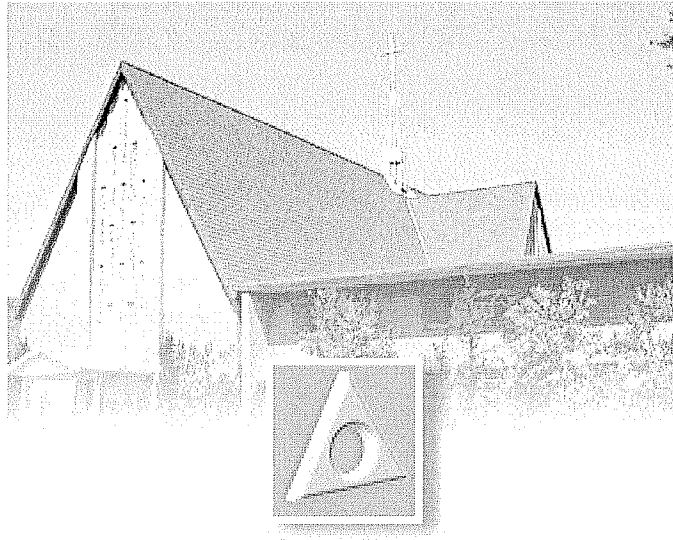

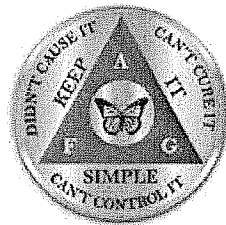
