

IT TAKES MANY HANDS TO COMPLETE A CIRCLE AND WE NEED YOURS

The following details need to be covered in order to make our Gratitude Night a wonderful experience

*SET UP: (4:30 pm) **Group:**

Need 4-5 people

- *Help put table clothes, placemats and decorations on the tables.
- *Set up the Raffle table with tickets, cash box and baskets to put the tickets in.
- * Start coffee and hot water and set up the beverage table with tea, cups, bowls for ice
- * Set up food table. Put out plates, cups, silverware, and napkins
- *Set up ticket cups for the baskets on the stage.

FOOD RUNNERS (5:00 PM) Group:

Need 4-5 people

- *Put food on table, (if you need utensils the church has spoons that we can use –just be sure they are put away when done using them) and replenish food as it is depleted, and remove empty containers.
- *Wash dishes as they are emptied and put on the counter for people to pick up at the end of the evening.
- *Keep an eye on the coffee and hot water, and brew more as needed.

RAFFLE TICKET TABLE: (5:00 pm) Group:

Need 2-3 people

- *Keep track of the tickets sold and money and make sure all tickets are in the right container.
- *During dinner, be sure the money and tickets are secured –
- * We will not sell tickets during the time the speakers are speaking we will sell tickets again after the speakers

Do you really know...

It's been an observation lately, that sponsorship is rarely talked about even by our long timers. What's up with that?

First, let me clarify – I am talking about an Al-Anon **Personal** Sponsor. That would be by definition from the Al-Anon Alateen Service Manual – "Some one with whom a member can confidentially discuss personal problems or questions and someone who willingly shares the experience, strength and hope of the Al-Anon program". The Service Manual goes on to say, "After a period of time, Al-Anon members will want to choose a personal Sponsor with whom they can identify. Members can encourage newcomers to find a Sponsor by sharing that Sponsors provide guidance; however, Sponsors do not direct or give advice. The new member may have discussed problems with the contact before coming to meetings. This contact may or may not be asked to continue as a Sponsor; however, neither a contact nor a newly-chosen Sponsor should be used as a substitute for a meeting. Additional information is published in the pamphlet *Sponsorship. What It's All About* (P31), and in the bookmark *Sponsorship – Working Together to Recover* (M-78), as well as on the Al-Anon/Alateen Members' Web site in the "Individuals" tab.

Women may relate to this scenario. Have you ever used the ladies room, and when you walk out you've accidentally gotten your skirt tucked into your panty hose and your butt is showing. It is amazing to me how many people will not tell you. Perhaps they are embarrassed for you. Perhaps they don't want to hurt your feelings by making you uncomfortable. So, they let you continue to walk around with your butt showing to the whole world! Wow what a nice friend!

Back in the day, there were a few things you did to get better. You got a sponsor. You did what your sponsor told you to do, and a sponsor could tell you if you had your skirt tucked into your panty hose.

What am I trying to say? Well, it seems that we've become so "Politically Correct" that we are no longer honest. That lack of honesty can be with a new person or a person who has been around for a while too. We've become "Lovingly Tolerant". At least that's what some call it. I call it ENABLING! I am not helping anyone if I let them continue a behavior that is unacceptable and label it being "Lovingly Tolerant". For God's Sake, be good friend and tell them to check their panty hose!

To be a good sponsor I need to be a good friend.
