### WHO IS THE AKRON INTERGROUP:

The Akron Area Al-Anon Intergroup Service Office is a small office on Manchester Rd. in Akron whose purpose is to support the work of Al-Anon in the greater Akron area. It is staffed Monday-Friday by Al-Anon members who volunteer their time. A board of officers (also volunteers) ensure that the work of Al-Anon is in accordance with the Twelve Traditions and Concepts of Service.

#### OUR PURPOSE:

- 1. Handle questions from groups on policy, Intergroup relations and any internal problems
- 2. Provide information about Al-Anon/Alateen recovery to individuals and organizations.
- 3. Maintain an inventory of Conference Approved Al-Anon literature, books and pamphlets for purchase by members and groups
- 4. Issue a monthly newsletter.
- 5. Encourage new Al-Anon Family Groups and support their growth.
- 6. Maintain a website of Al-Anon/Alateen for our northeastern Ohio service area.

### INTERGROUP MEETING MINUTES OF November 5th, 2024

Kristina H. called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM with the Serenity Prayer. Pat A read the Traditions.

Present:

Carla M, Hudson Friday Tracy C, Steering Committee Pat A., How to Recover Monday Don V., PIC, ISR, Serenity Seekers, Tues.

Kristina H, Intergroup Chair Irena H. GR 51, ISR Firestone Park

Secretary: Pat A asked for corrections or changes to last month's minutes. Don V moves to approve the minutes, Irena H. 2<sup>nd</sup>, motion passed.

Co-Chair: Jane was not present, but Kristina reported that the Oct. newsletter went out.

Treasurer: Carla M. See attached Treasurer's report for details.

Income for the month: \$2696.68

Expenses for the month: \$2209.94. We had a surplus this month of \$486.00! Book sales were us as we sold a lot of the newest book.

Beginning balance: \$16586.25

Ending balance: \$17077.99. There are currently \$1031.11 in outstanding book orders, but none are delinquent past 60 days.

We had several donations from local meetings. Tracy C suggests we continue to encourage our local groups to make regular monthly donations to Intergroup. Currently our appeal letter goes out twice a year. We also had a \$100.00 donation in honor of a "wedding". There was discussion about whether we could accept the donation, Carla will follow up and determine if the money is from an "Alanon member" as we cannot accept outside donations.

Irena H. moved to accept the treasurer's report, Don V 2<sup>nd</sup>. Motion passed.

Literature: Kristina reported that the Founder's Day committee asked if we would consider moving our literature to another room. There was discussion but the group felt that staying in the current room was better than moving to a new one. Irena reported that new literature is on order.

PIC: Don V Nothing new to report. Please continue to distribute our Alanon information wherever possible.

MOW: Edie K – No Report

Alateen: No report. Arena H. would like to see us find an Alateen Coordinator for Intergroup. She is concerned about staying current with the new changes to the Alateen program.

Office Coordinator: Janet reported there were 32 calls in, 14 calls out, 4 voice messages, and 4 visitors in the office. Tracy inquired about how many volunteers we have in the office, Irena reported 5 regular and 7 total. She also said we had volunteers in the office 23 days in Oct.

OAA Liaison: Irena talked about the updated Alateen sponsorship process recently enacted. New procedures and processes are being developed to comply with current laws.

Districts: Still no DR for District 25. We need someone to take over District 51. Gratitude night is coming, and 2025 project money will be designated to purchase an Alanon Manual for every group. Irena plans to coordinate with groups to see which ones receive emails from WSO, and which ones need manuals. She has purchased 15 so far. She will encourage electing a DR if a district does not have one. She also reported that currently some groups are growing, and some are dormant. She will have a schedule for workshops next month.

Webmaster: Ritchie T – No Report

Archives: Bonny B - No Report.

Steering Committee: Tracy C. – Tracy C. reported that she and Kristina et to discuss ways to encourage Alanon members to attend Founder's Day. Possibly develop a flyer for Alanon that can be distributed to states near Ohio via district or group emails. Irena suggested looking into "AFG Connect".

Founder's Day: Tracy reports plans are all set. Julie is going to do a session on Alanon "History". Leads are in place.

Old Business: Irena would like to see us have a better system to "archive" information about Founder's Day. This would help pass on information to the next coordinator, ie: what worked, what didn't work Etc.

New Business: None

Meeting adjourned at 8:21 pm with the Alanon declaration.
